JUICE ORANGES

Valencias are in full swing now and supply exceeds demand. This looks like it is going to be a long and healthy season. Juice bars should be flying. Overall very promotable with competitive pricing.

CLEMENTINES

We expect to have Sunkist "Delites" through to June. Please see your sales rep for pricing on bulk or bags. These are the best option on the market right now. Stem & leaf from Spain are done. Finally, Orris from Israel are available; pick up yours today.

LEMONS

The global lemon market is down; it will be a buyer's market for a while. Argentina is starting to ship. USA lemons are the best option right now. Prices are rising now due to freight and light increase in freight on board. The US lemons should be top choice through until May. Meyer lemons also available in 18 x 1 lb presentation.

Bunch broccoli is available from California; steady pricing and promotable.

CAULIFLOWER

Good supplies from California; Holiday demand has firmed the market.

CELERY

Supply is extremely limited.

CUCUMBER

Demand picked up slightly over the weekend. Overall, demand seems to be strong but there is a lot of product available.

PEPPERS

Spanish hot house is in good supply. Market for green peppers is steady with good supply out of Florida and Mexico. Jalapeños are very limited, with supplies coming out of Florida and Mexico.



LETTUCE

Market firmed back up as we transition growing regions.

TOMATOES

We are seeing 5/6 and 6/6 prices rise slightly. Supplies are tightening.

HOT HOUSE TOMATOES

Demand is still strong. Market doesn't seem to be letting loose this week. Canadian product is coming but not in full swing for another 3-4 weeks.

ROMA TOMATOES

Supplies have stabilized; expect prices to hold.

GRAPE TOMATOES

We are excited to get rolling with our Canadian season this year with Tomberry. Cherry tomatoes out of Canada also are hitting very strong levels for flavour. The rest of our snacking tomatoes are coming from the USA until late June when our new lit culture tomato crop will start.

ONIONS

Ontario cooking onion pricing will remain high. We carry US 8x3 lb and 10 lb red onions; market is fluctuating. Washington yellow Spanish (jumbo and colossal) and red (jumbo) are available. Market is steady; prices remain high. Mexican new crop red and yellow sweet onions have started; good quality and promotable.

CARROTS

Ontario carrots are still available in 2, 3 and 5 lb bags. Market pricing in cello will remain high. Ontario product is starting to end. Mexican jumbo carrots have started.

POTATOES

Florida potatoes are available, great quality but market is very active, prices for white are expected to go up dramatically. Washington purple c potatoes are still available. PEI baking potatoes are in stock, showing good quality. Washington baking potato prices are steady. Ontario 10 lb potatoes in red and white will remain high due to the high demand. Ontario 10 lb Yukon gold are done for the season, we do have 10 lb yellow flesh from PEI.
